
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
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
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
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
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1. **GOVERNOR**: This plate is assigned to the Governor of the State of New Jersey.
2. **U. S. SENATE**: The number 1 plate in this category is assigned to the Senior Senator. The number 2 plate is assigned to the Junior United States Senator of this State.
3. **U.S. CONGRESS**: Issued to United States Congressmen from the State of New Jersey. This plate bears the Congressional District number.
4. **CABINET**: Issued to members of the Governor's Cabinet.
5. **SENATE**: Issued to New Jersey State Senators.
6. **ASSEMBLY**: Issued to New Jersey State Assemblymen.
- 7 & 8. **COURTESY PLATE**: Low numbered plate displayed on passenger type vehicles.
9. **MEDICAL DOCTOR**: Issued to Medical Doctors only.
10. **DAV**: Issued to Disabled American Veterans.
11. **PASSENGER**: Issued to regular passenger vehicles, including passenger vehicles used for commercial purposes. The latter will have a non-passenger registration certificate.
12. **HIGHWAY**: Assigned to official vehicles of the State Highway Department.
13. **MOTOR VEHICLE**: Assigned to official vehicles operated by Motor Vehicle Inspectors.
14. **STATE GOVERNMENT**: Assigned to official vehicles operated by State employees.
15. **STATE POLICE**: Assigned to official vehicles operated by State Police.
16. **COUNTY GOVERNMENT**: Assigned to County owned vehicles.
17. **MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT**: Assigned to Municipally owned vehicles.
18. **TURNPIKE**: Issued to New Jersey Turnpike Authority and individuals employed by the Turnpike Authority.
19. **NO FEE**: Assigned to vehicles owned by non-profit organizations.
20. **NEW CAR DEALER**: Issued to franchised new car dealers.
21. **USED CAR DEALER**: Issued to non-franchised or used car dealers.
22. **COMMERCIAL**: Issued to general non-passenger type vehicles.
23. **OMNIBUS**: Issued to for-hire vehicles – buses and taxi cabs.
24. **FARMER**: Issued to vehicles owned by individuals engaged in the growing and raising of farm products. These plates may be placed upon motor trucks engaged exclusively in the carrying or transportation of registrants farm products raised or produced on his farm, and farm supplies and not engaged in hauling for hire.
25. **FARM USE**: Issued to motor vehicles used exclusively as farm machinery implements. Vehicles so registered may not traverse more than five miles of highway in traveling from one farm to another, may not be used to deliver or transport any farm products, goods, wares or merchandise, except from one farm to another, may not be operated on the highway at any time between sunset and sunrise, nor may it be operated on the highway if equipped with wheels of a type that will damage the highway.
26. **TRACTOR**: Issued to traction or tractor, well-drill machines or well-drilling equipment or trucks with powered feed impregnating machines.
27. **CONSTRUCTOR**: Issued to an applicant who is actually engaged in construction work or in the business of supplying materials, transporting material, or using such registered vehicles for construction work. Maximum gross registered weight, or load, may not exceed 70,000 pounds.
28. **CONTRACTOR EQUIPMENT IN TRANSIT**: These plates can be placed on any road building machinery, vehicle, traction engine, steam roller or other apparatus or machinery owned or operated by a person, partnership or corporation to whom the registration is issued only in moving to and from the location of any kind of construction.
29. **TRAILER**: Issued for use on all types of trailers and trailer type vehicles.
30. **MOTORCYCLE**: Issued for all types of motorcycles and motor scooters. This plate may not be displayed on a motorcycle or motorcycle type vehicle which is used for commercial purposes. The Commercial motorcycle license plate is prefixed by the letter "X".
31. **TEMPORARY PLATES**: Temporary cardboard plates issued by a licensed motor vehicle dealer to permit operation of the vehicle for a period not to exceed 21 days or until such time as the cardboard plate is replaced by a regular license plate. Date issued, expiration date, make of vehicle, and serial number of vehicle must be affixed to this plate at the time of issuance.
32. **DIMENSIONS**: Bolt hole locations and material used in construction of New Jersey license plates.

*All license plates that have a rectangular block between the letters "N" and "J" or beneath the letters "NJ" are validated each year by a color year designator sticker. The sticker must be placed on the license plates April 1st of each year.

Plates in categories 1 through 19 are validated through the use of an inspection sticker which is displayed in the lower right hand corner of the windshield. This sticker displays a numeral which indicates the month of expiration.

The registration year in plate categories 21 through 30 begins on April 1, and ends on March 31st of the following year.
